## **LIFE JACKET LOANER STATION**

All boaters, adults, and children are encouraged to wear a life jacket while boating. All boats must have at least one coast guard approved life jacket for each person on board. Vessels over 16 feet must also have one throwable flotation device on board. Children 12 and under must wear a life jacket at all times when aboard a boat less than 19 feet in length.

The Port of Edmonds has a Life Jacket Loaner Station, located at the head of the Fuel Dock/Guest Moorage dock. Boaters may borrow the life jackets to replace missing or damaged life jackets, or use them for extra guests aboard their boats. To keep the station running, we also accept and encourage donations of good, useable life jackets.
