## VESSEL SAFETY INSPECTIONS



A vessel safety check (VSC) is a free, 15-point inspection performed by a U.S. Coast Guard-approved vessel examiner. This voluntary inspection takes about 20 to 30 minutes and is designed to ensure that your boat has the appropriate safety equipment on board and it's in proper working order. If your boat passes the exam, it receives a VSC annual decal on the port side of the cabin or console. There are no consequences for boats that don't pass a VSC, in fact, over 50% of boats don't pass a VSC on the first try. Whether your boat passes or not, you will learn valuable information about boat safety. Common reasons for not passing the examination include:

- No boat registration
- Discharged fire extinguisher
- Malfunctioning navigation lights
- Lack of age-appropriate life jackets
- Improper letters/numbers or spacing of the state registration number on the boat
- Expired or insufficient number of signal flares

US Coast Guard Auxiliary personnel will be available and ready to perform inspections from 10am-3pm in front of the Port of Edmonds Marina Operations office on July 14, August 11, September 8 and October 13, 2018.

### Marine Area 9

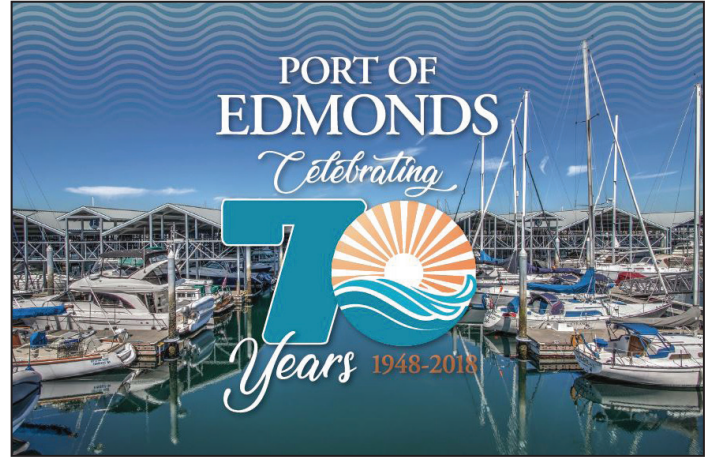
Recreation crab fishing open through September 3. Chinook opens July 16–August 15.

### Marine Area 10

Chinook opens July 16–August 30. Minimum size is 22" on chinooks, no minimum size for other salmon species. Daily limit 2. Only 1 hatchery chinook may be retained. Recreation crab fishing open through September 3rd.

## HIRING COMMERCIAL VENDORS

Port regulations acknowledge that boat owners sometimes choose to use casual labor for incidental services such as washing, detailing or carpet cleaning. However, for any work considered hazardous or of a technical nature, the vendor must be on the Port's commercial vendor list and comply with all commercial work rules while on Port property.

The Port of Edmonds does not recommend use of any specific businesses, but maintains a list for customer use of commercial vendors who have provided the Port with proof of insurance, are committed to following Best Management Practices in the marina, boatyard and dry storage, maintain City business license, and follow all Port, local, state and federal requirements appropriate to their business. Commercial vendors who meet these requirements have access to the Port docks and are authorized to perform work on Port property.
